Micky received his acting training at Theatre Aquarius School of Performing Arts, on a full scholarship for all round ability, and later studied dance at the University of Waterloo. His ongoing training includes Masterclass Workshops with Nancy Bishop (European Casting Director for American productions), Paul Weber (former Head Casting Director MGM Studios) and Ivana Chubbuck (Acting Coach to Brad Pitt, Halle Berry, Charlize Theron, Jim Carrey etc). His latest theatrical credits include the roles of Feste in Shakespeare's Twelfth Night at Teatro Belli (Rome), Talthybius in Euripides' Women of Troy at Teatro San Genesio (Rome) and De Vere in Moira Buffini's Loveplay at Teatro Arciliuto (Rome). This is in addition to a host of international credits, including King Herod in Jesus Christ Superstar (Canada), Alfred Doolittle in My Fair Lady (Ireland), and Puck in A Midsummer Night's Dream (New Zealand). His film credits include the lead role of Nicephore Niepce in The Imago, which won Best Production at the Manchester International Film Festival, and the High Pharisee in Jesus VR The Story of Christ, which premiered at The Venice International Film Festival (Berlinale). Micky is represented by the Luca Confortini at the prestigious Del Fuego Management in Milan (Christopher Lambert, Rutger Hauer, William Baldwin, Lindsay Lohan).

Micky began his career in musical theatre at the age of 15, performing in large professional venues. He has since held lead roles in more than 20 productions over 5 countries. He trained in Bel Canto singing with Elisabetta Toyama, and is a multi-instrumentalist (Irish harp, mandolin, bouzouki, flute, bodhran). A charismatic frontman and entertainer, his bands have headlined numerous international folk festivals to rave reviews ("One of those rare cases where the live performance absolutely outshone their impressive biographies." For more than 10 years he shared his time between traditional Irish music in Clifden Galway and international touring projects, performing with the Auckland Philharmonia Orchestra, opening for Neil Finn (of Crowded House), performing at the Australasian APRA Music Awards, and singing live on BBC radio. An award-winning songwriter, Micky is the Musical Director for both Eternal Lines and Blue Tiger Theatre in Italy, where he has composed music for more than 12 productions. He continues to tour Europe with the Irish folk band The Liberties, receiving widespread accolades for his original songs.
